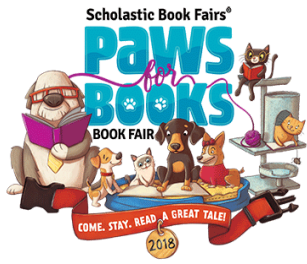
Spring Concert, Tuesday, May 8 in the Church, 6:00 p.m.
